Sheryl Fullen vs. Springfield Technical Community College:

Five Stones Venture Fights Back After Religious Discrimination

“We must not allow or give support to mere personal or political preferences masquerading as religious liberty claims,” quoted Sheryl Fullen’s employer, in a letter denying her request for a religious accommodation to their COVID-19 vaccine policy. Sheryl’s faith in Christ and her Christian conscience prevented her from taking abortion-derived drugs, including the new COVID-19 vaccines. Thus, she sought an accommodation to Springfield Technical Community College’s vaccination policy. She didn’t know it at the time, but that decision to honor her religious beliefs would change her life.

In a country founded on the principles of religious freedom, Sheryl never imagined she would be *fired* for her faith. But that’s exactly what happened.

Sheryl’s request for a religious exemption was denied, her pleas for accommodation unanswered, and her employment terminated. She was met with a sham interactive process and no opportunity to appeal the employer’s decision.

But Sheryl is fighting back, her faith stronger than ever.
